History

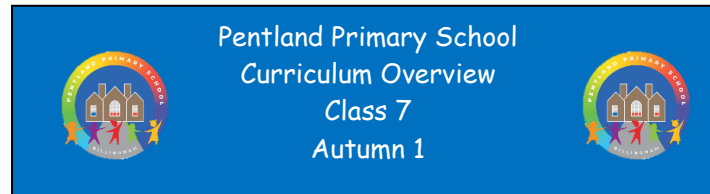
