We will not have a set PE day. During our days we have our OT sessions and spend our time during outdoor play practicing catching/throwing skills. Many of us also use the climbing equipment available.

English

We will be working hard to become better readers by practising our reading skills every day.

We will have activities out throughout the day to help with our spellings and developing our interest in letter and words. There will be lots of opportunities for us to practice our letter formations and play with words.

We will share books and stories as a class. These will be aimed at our interests so that we can develop a love for stories.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills which will help us when we practise our handwriting.

Attention Autism

We will be starting Attention Autism with your children during this term. This will help your children to develop attention and communication skills using visually appealing toys and activities to engage the children in fun sessions.

These sessions will help to develop their listening, joint attention and turn-taking skills.

Creative (Art, Music)

Our Art will be messy play based; this will allow us to discover different textures whilst also being creative.

We will explore sound making during this term which will allow us to discover different sounds.



Life skills

We will be learning skills to help us develop our independence.

Understanding emotions

We will talk about our emotions every day and think about how we react in different situations as well as discovering ways in which we can self-regulate.

Sensory

We will explore different tastes, textures and sounds. We are going to focus on trying new foods with a variation of different textures. We will keep parents up to date with the foods your child likes.

Maths

Our maths topics this half term include:
