

### Creative (Art, DT, Music)

Our art and DT work will link to Ancient Egypt.

We will be playing different rhythms on the drums and putting them together to compose a piece of music.

We will listen to some old and new Egyptian music.

### Humanities (History, Geography)

We will be locating Egypt on the world map then finding out about life in Ancient Egypt.

We will learn about the River Nile, Tutankhamun and mummies.

We'll watch some Horrible Histories clips which the children could watch at home with you.

### Science

Our topic is Animals, including humans.

We will learn about:

- food groups
- animal groups
- the skeleton
- muscles

### PE

Our PE will be gymnastics and movement work, in addition to playing team games and improving throwing and catching skills.



### RE

We will be learning about the importance of the bible to Christians.

### English

We will be working hard to become better readers by practising our reading skills every day.

We will share books and texts as a class so that we can write descriptive sentences and paragraphs and write factual reports about Ancient Egypt.

We will have lessons to improve our spelling, punctuation and grammar.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills which will help us when we practise our handwriting.

Our PE lessons are on Tuesday and Thursday. No additional kit is needed; however, if your child comes to school in wellies, please ensure they have trainers or plimsolls to change into on these days.

### Life skills

We will be learning skills to help us develop our independence and we will practise some of these when we visit the shops.

### Understanding emotions

We will talk about our emotions every day and think about how we react in different situations.

### Sensory

We will explore different tastes, textures and sounds.

### Maths

Our maths topics this half term include:

- representing numbers
- ordering numbers
- counting multiples
- finding 1 and 10 more/less than a number
- reading and writing numbers in numerals and words
- partitioning numbers
- addition and subtraction
- using money
- practising tables, particularly 2, 4, 5 and 10x.
