### Art

We are continuing to create sculptures in the image of George Segal and Ray Lonsdale. The children will be using clay and paper mâché and will be appraising their own and their peers' work.

### DT

We are designing wind turbines in accordance with a brief using research and drafting to formulate our ideas.

### Music

Sing a broad range of Gospel songs with a sense of ensemble and performance.

### History

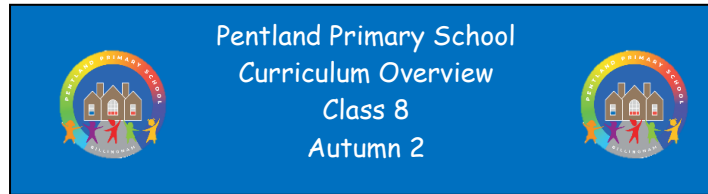
