Art

In art we are learning all about the artist Edvard Munch who is known for his work in producing portraits. We will be using sketching and painting to create our very own portrait. We will be looking at how different colours make us feel and how we can show our emotions in our artwork.

DT

In DT we will be designing and making our own tower. We will be researching how to make a tower and how to make it strong. We will be using spaghetti and, marshmallows to build our own creative tower.

Music

In music we are looking at Reggae music! We will be learning different songs and dances and exploring which instruments are used in Reggae, particularly listening to the music from Bob Marley.

PE

This half term we will be learning different dance routines focusing on balancing and listening carefully to the song to remember a routine. We will also be continuing to work on our team building exercises by playing ball games, listening and working with our friends to hit the goal.

The children have already taken part in their first lesson this week and I have been super impressed with the skills and efforts!

Computing

In computing we are recapping how to be safe on the internet and who our trusted adults are. We will be understanding how technology has changed over time and how what we post online can last for a very long time for others to see.

We will also be learning about how to follow a set of instructions to allow a robot to move in different directions.

Humanities (History, Geography)

Geography

We will be learning all about cold places, looking at how the world is divided by the equator into the Northern Hemisphere, and Southern Hemisphere. We have started to understand why different places are colder than others, and warmer than others. We have looked at how shade and wind can affect the temperature and how we measure temperature using a thermometer.

History

Read Write Inc - Phonics

During Autumn we will be continuing to attend our daily Read Write Inc phonics lessons. We will be working hard to practice all of our new sounds and recap all of the sounds that we already know. This is really helping with our reading and writing.

Writing - Year 1

In year 1 we will be continuing to practice our dictated sentences on our story book and becoming more independent writers. Focusing on our full stops, capital letters and finger spaces, making sure we use are individual phonics knowledge to spell our words.

Science

Topic - Plants.

In science this term we will be learning all about plants, looking at the structure of a plant and the parts that it has, then linking this to the structure of a tree. We will be learning about the similarities and differences between evergreen trees and deciduous trees, and looking at the types of flowers which grow in the wild and which can be planted and grown in a back garden.

RE

What does it mean to belong to Sikhism.

This term class 3 are going to be learning about the religion Sikhism. The children will get to understand what Sikhs believe in and their rules they follow, they will learn what they wear and why, they will also understand what it means to belong in this religion and how Sikhs celebrate.
