Art

DT

History

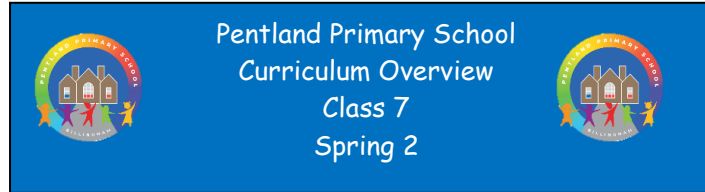
This half term, we will be studying WW1 and understanding the causes and chronology. We will be answering the question, "How did the Great War affect local people and their communities?"
