## English

We will be working hard to become better readers by practising our reading skills every day.

We will share books and stories as a class. These will be aimed at our interests so that we can develop a love for stories.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills which will help us when we practise our handwriting.

## Attention Autism

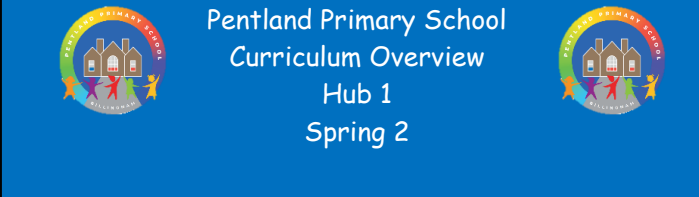
We will be continuing Attention Autism with your children during this term. This will help your children to develop attention and communication skills using visually appealing toys and activities to engage the children in fun sessions.

These sessions will help to develop their listening, joint attention and turn-taking skills.

## Creative (Art, Music)

Our Art will be messy play based; this will allow us to discover different textures whilst also being creative.

We will explore sound making during this term which will allow us to discover different sounds.



## Life skills

We will be learning skills to help us develop our independence.

## Understanding emotions

We will talk about our emotions every day and think about how we react in different situations as well as discovering ways in which we can self-regulate.

## Sensory

We will explore different tastes, textures and sounds. We are going to focus on trying new foods with a variation of different textures. We will keep parents up to date with the foods your child likes.

## Role Play

This term we will explore doing role play as a group. We will link this to the book we are reading to help us understand the book more.

## Science

In science we are going to look at animals commonly found during Spring. As well as looking at life cycles, 'baby' animals and what animals they grow in to.

## Maths

Our maths topics this half term include:

- representing numbers
- ordering numbers
- counting multiples
- finding 1 and 10 more/less than a number
- reading and writing numbers in numerals and words
- addition and subtraction
- using money
- Number patterns (2s, 5s & 10s)
- Skip counting (2s, 5s & 10s)
- Sorting by colour and shape

This term will link activities to the book we are reading. The books we will look at this term are:

- Chicken Licken
- Farmer Duck
- The Tale of a Naughty Little Rabbit
