

Creative (Art, DT, Music)

We will be developing our music knowledge of pulse and rhythm and identifying these in different songs.

We will be playing some accompaniments to these songs using percussion instruments.

Science

Our topic is Rocks.

We will learn about:

- different types of rocks
- how rocks change over time;
- how fossils are formed;
- how soils are made

Maths

Our maths topics this half term include:

- multiplication
- division
- fractions
