

Creative (Art, DT, Music)

Art

In Art during Summer 1 the children will be learning how to use fine lines and shapes to create and sketch a flower. They will then use colour mixing to create different tones to create their own flower garden.

DT

In DT we will be learning about the food plate and what healthy eating is, exploring each part of the food plate for example dairy and carbohydrates. We will then be designing and making our own picnic exploring food hygiene and food safety when preparing the meal.

Music

In music we are looking at Reggae music! We will be exploring how to use and play a glockenspiel, and learn how to copy musical melodies from the teacher first.

PE

During this half term the children will be developing their skills in playing boundary line and working on their hand coordination with the ball and their bat, working with partners and in groups to complete different learning objectives with the ball. They will be developing their skills to hold a bat correctly to hit a ball, throwing a ball underarm and catching the ball, throwing the ball overarm and rolling a ball and stopping the ball correctly.

They will also be completing a dance routine, where they will learn to improvise and choreograph a routine while listening to a piece of music using different body movements and learning how to respond to music in different ways and tempos.

Computing

In computing we are learning all about how to use a keyboard correctly, they will be learning how to write their own name, and their friend's name. How to delete text and change the font of texts as well as adding capital letters to a sentence and using the backspace to delete a letter. Finally, they will learn how to safely and successfully save their work into their own folder on the computer and log in correctly.

Humanities (History, Geography)

Geography

During this term we will be completing lots of outdoor walks and being detectives to see what we can find. We will be also looking at explaining the difference if something is dead, alive or was never alive.
