In music this half term we will be learning to play the *Glockenspiel*!

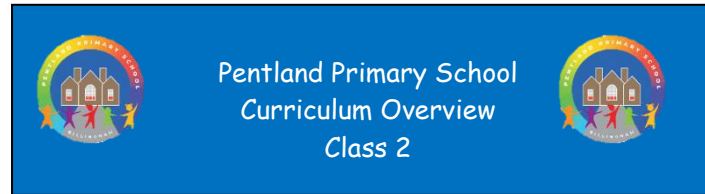
Computing

This half term in science we will be learning all about living things. We will start by learning how we classify living, dead or never alive. Then we will look at how we know something is alive. We will then move on to look at the different types of habitats that living things can live in.

PE

In PE this half term we will be revisiting our dance topic. We will learn to choreograph our own dance routines focusing on improvisation.

RE

This half term we will be answering the big question 'What does it mean to belong to the Muslim Community?' focusing upon Muslim beliefs and practices. In this unit, pupils will explore the religion Islam and learn all about significant traditions.

Humanities (History, Geography)

Geography

The children will be answering the big question 'What are hot places like and how can we locate them'. We will use globes and atlases to help us identify different countries that are known for hot weather. We will also learn about the equator and how this affects the weather.

History

This half term, we will be answering the big question 'How have photographs changed over time' studying photos from the past and learning all about how historians use photographs. We will explore how photography has changed over time and how this has impacted significant historic discoveries.
