Art

Throughout Spring term in art, children will be focusing on and creating artwork based on Egyptian masks, appraising traditional Egyptian masks as well and learning to make their own using clay and acrylic paints.

DT

Humanities (History, Geography)

Geography

In Geography this term we will be focusing on the country Italy and answering the question 'What is it like to live in Northern Italy?'. We will be exploring northern Italy, village and town life as well as making comparisons to our region

History
