English.

We will be learning to write a letter to persuade, a narrative to entertain, another explanation text to inform and a poetry writing focus.

In grammar we will be learning about questions, statements and commands, sentence types, word types, adverbials, expanded noun phrases and speech.

We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts alongside poetry. These will support comprehension.

Science

Topic - Electricity.

This term in science will be focusing on the topic of electricity. This will involve looking at circuits and their components, making our own circuits and comparing conductors and insulators.

RE

We will be learning about Islam and all about Mosques, how they are used and the importance of them We will discover the meaning of ummah and discover the meaning of the word 'sacred' and its relation to Islam.

Maths

In maths Y3s will be learning the 7 times tables. The Y4s will be consolidating previously learnt times tables and their corresponding division facts.

Y3/Y4

Both year 3 and 4 will continue exploring measuring capacity, temperature and money. We will also be focusing on geometry and completing further work on the four operations and consolidating all of this year's learning. As well as this we will be having regular arithmetic lessons to strengthen knowledge on the four operations.
