Creative (Art, DT, Music)

Throughout autumn term in art, children will be focusing on and creating artwork based on Greek pottery, appraising traditional Greek pottery as well and learning to make their own using clay and acrylic paints.

In DT, we will be designing and creating a decorative pillow case, learning skills such as embroidery.

In music, we will be learning to play the glockenspiel and taking a look at a range of music within the disco genre to accompany our instrument playing.

Humanities (History, Geography) Geography

In Geography this term we will focusing on land use within the United Kingdom, answering the question 'How diverse are local and U.K. landscapes?' We will be exploring our local area, comparisons across the United Kingdom.
