Art

We will be exploring the artist Vincent Can Gogh. We will explore his work and discuss what we like and dislike about his pieces. We will learn the names of his famous paintings and use some of his techniques in our own work.

DT

We will be learning about different types of puppets. Specifically finger puppets, hand puppets and string puppets. We will design and create our own puppet over the half term.

Music

Music lessons this half term will be delivered by music teacher, Mrs Galloway. We will be learning all about pop music.

PE

This half term we will be learning different dance routines focusing on balancing and listening carefully to the song to remember a routine. We will also be continuing to work on our team building exercises by playing ball games, listening and working with our friends to hit the goal.

Humanities (History, Geography)

Geography

This half term we will be exploring our planet Earth. We will discuss how the Earth is the place we live and is made up of land and oceans. We will learn the names of the 7 continents and learn a little bit about each continent.

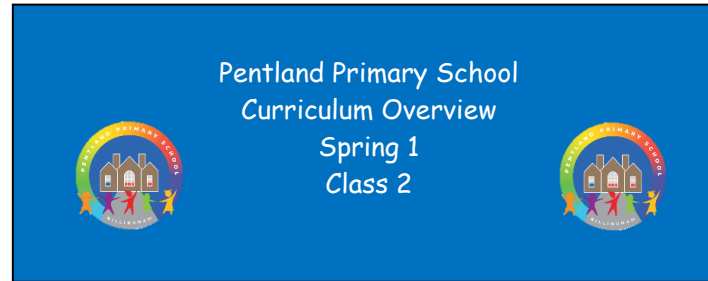
History

Computing

In computing we are recapping how to be safe on the internet and who our trusted adults are. We will be understanding how technology has changed over time and how what we post online can last for a very long time for others to see.

We will also be learning about how to follow a set of instructions to allow a robot to move in different directions.

Science

Topic - Everyday materials

This half term we will be exploring everyday materials and their properties. We will discuss how materials can be categorised by their properties and we will engage with lots of hands on activities to help the children make connections to real life experiences. A key focus for us will be recording data when thinking about working scientifically.

In this unit, pupils will learn...

- what money is - that money comes in different forms
- how money is obtained (e.g. earned, won, borrowed, presents)
- how people make choices about what to do with money, including spending and saving
- the difference between needs and wants - that people may not always be able to have the things they want how to keep money safe and the different ways of doing this

RE: What does it mean to belong to Sikhism?

This term class 3 are going to be learning about the religion Sikhism. The children will get to understand what Sikhs believe in and their rules they follow, they will learn what they wear and why, they will also understand what it means to belong in this religion and how Sikhs celebrate.
