Art

DT

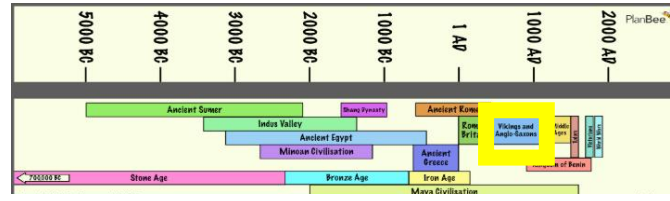
Humanities (History, Geography)

In English this half term we will be learning to write the following texts:
